

EBSCO Publishing Databases Available through Clark County School District



■ MAS Ultra™ — School Edition

Designed specifically for high school libraries, this comprehensive database contains full text for more than 500 popular high school magazines, 85,670 biographies and 105,786 primary source documents. Additionally, *MAS Ultra — School Edition* contains more than 360 reference books and an Image Collection of 341,655 photos, maps & flags. All full-text articles are assigned a reading level indicator (Lexiles).

■ Middle Search® Plus

This database contains full text for more than 140 popular middle school magazines, as well as thousands of biographies and historical essays. Additionally, *Middle Search Plus* contains primary source documents including *Essential Documents in American History*, reference books including the *Funk & Wagnalls New World Encyclopedia* and *American Heritage® Dictionary*, 4th Edition from Houghton Mifflin, and an Image Collection of 341,655 photos, maps & flags.

■ Primary Search®

Designed with elementary school libraries in mind, this database contains full text for more than 70 popular elementary school magazines. Additionally, *Primary Search* features *Funk & Wagnalls New World Encyclopedia* and includes *EBSCO Animals™*, providing students with easy-to-read encyclopedic entries written specifically for kids. The database also provides the *American Heritage® Children's Dictionary*, 3rd Edition from Houghton Mifflin, and an extensive Image Collection.

■ General Science Collection™

This resource provides information on all aspects of the scientific world and offers full-text coverage for more than 60 of the most popular science publications. Subject areas covered include the observation, description, identification and experimental investigation of phenomena, and the application of science to industrial or commercial objectives.

■ EBSCO Animals™

This extensive database provides students with thousands of easy-to-read entries about mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians, fish, dinosaurs and prehistoric animals. Each entry begins with a simple category breakdown of the animal including Kingdom, Class, Order, Genus & Species and Geographical Locale as well as a detailed description. Many entries include colorful images.

■ TOPICsearch™

This current events database allows researchers to explore social, political & economic issues, scientific discoveries and other popular topics discussed in today's classrooms. *TOPICsearch* contains full text for over 105,000 articles from 1,622 diverse sources, including international and regional newspapers, periodicals, biographies, public opinion polls, book reviews, pamphlets and government information.

■ Newspaper Source™

This resource provides cover-to-cover full text for 35 leading national (U.S.) and international newspapers, as well as selective full text for 375 regional U.S. newspapers. In addition, full-text television & radio news transcripts are available.

■ Health Source®: Consumer Edition

This rich collection of consumer health information provides access to nearly 80 full-text consumer health magazines, as well as searchable full text for current health-related pamphlets and more than 130 health reference books. This resource also contains more than 5,100 Clinical Reference Systems reports (available in both English and Spanish); the *Lexi-PAL Drug Guide*, covering 1,300 generic drug patient education sheets with more than 4,700 brand names; and *Merriam-Webster's Medical Desk Dictionary*.

■ **MasterFILE™ Premier**

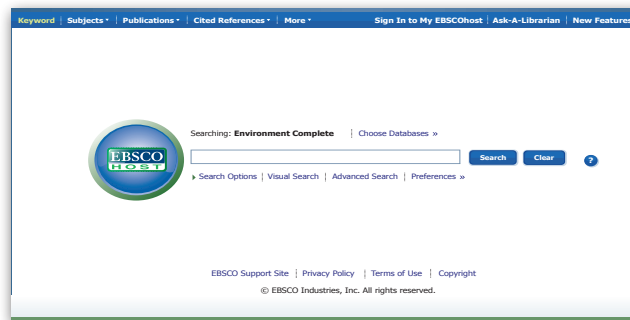

■ **Health Source®: Nursing/Academic Edition**

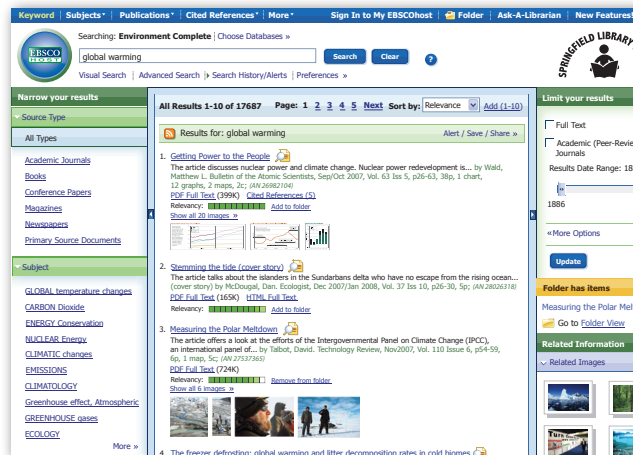

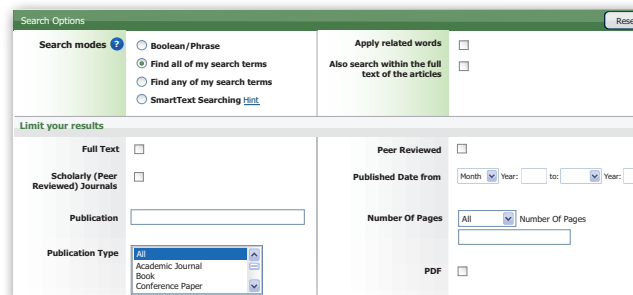
