



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, Nevada Reading Week has been celebrated statewide in schools and supported by school and public libraries for more than thirty years, and is celebrated as a week or over a month; and

WHEREAS, Reading for both pleasure and instruction is fundamental to success for all children; an annual event celebrating reading promotes literacy and encourages children to read widely and to choose a variety of books, just as it encourages teachers and librarians to promote reading at home as well as in the classroom; and

WHEREAS, Nevada Reading Week celebrations provide incentives to reading for children and their families; and

WHEREAS, librarians and teachers in schools across the state of Nevada have planned a variety of activities, educational events, and visits by children's authors during annual Nevada Reading Week celebrations, which are supported by public libraries as well; and

WHEREAS, Nevada Reading Week has traditionally been celebrated in late February or early March, often in conjunction with Dr. Seuss's birthday on March 2.
