

QUILT SQUARE PROJECT

Fiction Book

As we discussed in class, the book project this quarter is to create a quilt square. Your square needs to represent your book.

- Include a border that represents the theme of your book.
- Write your name (first and last) in one of the corners.
- Include a repeated design or symbol that represents a key idea from your book.
- Include the title and author on the front of the square
- On the back of the quilt square, write an explanation of the theme of the book with three supporting quotes from the text, explain your border, and explain the main illustration.
- Paper will be provided to create your quilt square. Do not lose this! If you do, you will be required to provide your own paper – the same size, color, and weight.

This assignment is due Friday, September 12th. If you have a planned absence on **September 12th, you need to turn your project in early.** If you have an unplanned absence (illness for example), this project will be **due the day you return to school.**

Quilt Square Grading Rubric

Illustrations (30 points)

- *Includes border and main illustration
- *Illustrations relate to the theme
- *Border includes symbols and colors

Written Description (30 points)

- *Quality of writing—discusses theme with three textual supports, explains illustrations, and explains the importance/significance of the border.
- *Grammar (Spelling, punctuation, and sentence structure)

Title and Author Included (20 points)

Time and Effort (10 points)

- *Neatness and details

Creativity (10 points)

Restrictions that Will Cause You to Receive No Credit:

- Plagiarism on any part of the book project (can't copy or write a direct quote from the book)
- Project based on anything other than a fiction book
